Tips on how to respect the X and make everyone feel included:

THE SFWFFLER

1. Learn people's pronouns and use them

Get into the habit of simply asking for pronouns and offering yours. For example, "Hi, I'm Rocco. I go by they/them, what pronouns do you use?" Yes, it's a little awkward at first, but what's more awkward is misgendering someone. It is definitely okay to make mistakes as long as you are actively trying to get it right.

2. Don't lump people into categories unless you actually know

Everyone enjoys the camaraderie in this league and there are many ways we show it! So unless you know that everyone in a group identifies as a "lady," consider swapping out "hey ladies" with "hey team" or "hey folks."

When picking someone to defend on the field, consider saying "I got that person" or "I got them" until you ask for pronouns.

3. Anyone can be non-binary

Surprise! Not just masculine presenting or "butch" people are non-binary and use they/them pronouns. So, please don't assume that someone goes by she/her if they are femme presenting. Again, the simple solution: just ask!
