Fast forward to January 2018: The league had dwindled to 45 players on 3 teams until Scheherazade and Al took over and grew the league to 98 players on 6 teams in the spring. Now, we are at 176 players on 10 teams for the fall 2018 season.

# INTERVIEW WITH THE LEAGUE VETERAN: MONICA WILEY **SFWFFL SINCE 1998**

Name: Monica Wiley Team: First String

Stefani: Monica, how long have you been in the SFWFFL? What year did you start? Monica: started when I was five years old. I was a very buff five-year-old. I seem to recall the year as 1998 . .

M: We started as a team named Women in Motion (or WIM). That team became "First String" in 2002.
